## The Soma Nomaoi Festival and Scenic Gourmet Experience



### SPOT 1

#### Horseback Riding on the Coast

Enjoy the beautiful Karasuzaki coast and forest on horseback in this area famous for traditional horse riding skills. Instructors will match your level, from beginner to experienced rider, so that you can best enjoy this rare chance to take part in one of Hamadori's unique offerings.  
Fee: ¥15,000 (Beach Ride), ¥4,400 (Town Ride)

### SPOT 2

#### Learn the History and Customs of the Area

The Minamisoma City Museum features the history of the Soma region, the local customs and other materials from its fascinating past. It has many exhibits related to the Soma Nomaoi, a lively annual festival that features the area's traditional horse competitions, and has been held for a thousand years.

Entry fee: Adults: ¥300 (may vary for special exhibitions)



### SPOT 3

#### Samurai Cosplay

Visitors can enjoy a samurai cosplay experience at the Meijokan in Minamisoma. Dressed in traditional armor from head to foot, you can stroll along the streets of the old town and act out a heroic experience as you imagine yourself taking a unique time trip back to the feudal age.

Fee: ¥10,000 (Reservations required)



### SPOT 4

#### Dine in a Stunning Spot on the Coast

The Nagisaryo Mojishima restaurant, with a stunning view of the shoreline, serves set menus made from local Joban fish and pesticide-free vegetables. Large floor-to-ceiling windows, polished concrete floors, and the Scandinavian furniture create a stylish and elegant dining atmosphere.

Fee: ¥4,500 (Reservations required)
