SPOT 1 Tasty Seafood at a Lively Fish Market

The Iwaki Lalamew seafront market offers the best of the local catch, including a wide variety of delicacies that can be cooked at the adjacent barbecue area. In addition, the facility offers a sightseeing boat trip for visitors to enjoy a panoramic view of the Pacific Ocean, and a bicycle rental service.

Fee: Adults: ¥1,800 (cruise ship)

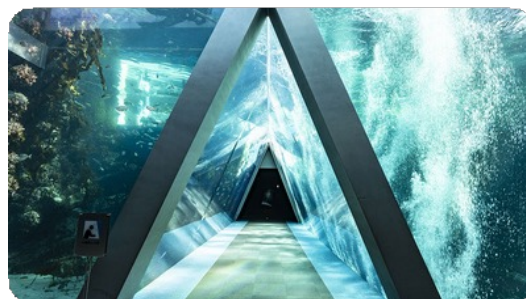

SPOT 2 Learn About the Marine Environment

The Aquamarine Fukushima Environmental Aquarium is the largest aquarium in northern Japan. The highlight of the interior space is the triangular tunnel that features the point where opposing currents meet off Fukushima's Pacific coast. The exhibits are both educating and entertaining.

Fee: ¥1,850 for adults



SPOT 3 Soak in Traditional Hot Springs

Iwaki Yumoto Onsen is the largest hot spring town in the Hamadori area of Fukushima, with a lively shopping street and the unique Onsen Shrine. You can not only soak in the healing waters of the hot springs, but also stroll around and discover local restaurants featuring traditional dishes.



SPOT 4 Enjoy a Theme-Park Spa Resort

Spa Resort Hawaiians features six theme parks, including indoor pools and water slides, and the largest open-air bath in the world. It also has four accommodation choices (including glamping), and other resort features, including a Hawaiian-style floor show performance and a golf course.
